**RE: HEALTH AND SAFETY PRECAUTIONS FOR BACK TO SCHOOL**

The main priority of Kweneng International School is the health and well being of learners, educators and workers. In line with this, the school is currently finalizing arrangements for meeting the standards set by the Ministries of both Health and Education in compliance with the COVID 19:

1. Cleaning and Fumigation of the school.
2. Setting up of sinks and sanitizers at the entrance to the school.
3. Arrangements of furniture in such a way that children maintain the recommended social distance.
4. Inspection of the school by both Ministries will be conducted in the presence of a PTA representative.
5. Training staff in the application of safety procedures.

**OTHER MEASURES TO BE TAKEN:**

1. The tuck shop will be closed in order to minimise the possibility of infection therefore students will pack food from home.
2. There will be no afternoon activities for forms one to four however the tutorial/remedial program will continue online via whatsapp.
3. Form fives will have extra lessons in the afternoon, from 13:45 to 15:15, in order to adequately prepare them for their IGCSE exams.
4. There will be orientation of students on safety measures conducted on opening day. Students will be continuously reminded of these measures during class registration and through posters.
5. Registration, sanitization/washing of hands and recording of daily temperatures of students will be done at the gate. In order to facilitate this process, Parents/ guardians are to drop the students by the gate.

6. Parents/guardians should ensure that students arrive at school before 7:15 to avoid delays and congestion.

7. No one will be allowed entry into the school without a face mask.

8. If your child/ward is unwell keep them at home until they are fully recovered.

9. If your child/ward falls ill at school, they will be immediately isolated. You will be called to come and collect them. In severe cases, an ambulance will be called to take the child/ward to the hospital.

The school calendar has been revised to meet the mandatory number of school calendar days required by the Ministry of Education. The revised version will be forward to you on the first day of second term via the students.
